Carter M. Reandeau, 71

Carter M. Reandeau, 71, of Tupper Lake, died Tuesday, October 30, 2007 at Kingston Hospital.

Born on December 24, 1935 in Tupper Lake, he was one of 16 children born to Alexander and Mary Jane (LaFave) Reandeau.

Carter was a graduate of Tupper High and a veteran of the U. S. Army serving from 1958 to 1960. After his service, he was employed at Ampersand Mountain in the fire tower. He also was a caretaker for many years for the Goodman's estate at Bog River. Carter eventually retired from Sunmount DDSO in 1999 as a boiler room assistant.

On April 16, 1969, he married Joanne Theriault in Bloomingdale. They had one son, David. The couple made their home in Newcomb and returned to Tupper Lake in 1970. Joanne predeceased him on February 18, 2002.

He was involved in the local Christian TV program, "The Word Goes Forth" since 1981 where he played and sang worship songs and prayer. He was a member of the Tupper Lake Christian Center for several

years and also played guitar in their worship group.

Carter is survived by his wife Mildred, one son, David and his wife Joanne and his only grandchild Sarah Emily, all of Tupper Lake. He is also survived by two sisters, Ruth LaPiere and Rita St. Pierre all of Tupper Lake and several nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by his first wife, Joanne; five sisters, Irene Beyer, Lottie Lanthier, Theresa Pilon, Freda Morrow, and Dinah Reandeau, eight brothers, Alexander Jr. "Chef-boy," Lawrence, Howard "Wigs," Leonard "Babes," Armand "Rabbit," Donald "Chick," Earl "Rico," and Clarence "Cudion" Reandeau.

Calling hours were held on Friday, November 2 at the Stuart-Fortune-Keough Funeral Home.

A funeral service was held Saturday at 10 a.m. at the funeral home. Burial followed in St. Alphonsus Cemetery with full military honors.

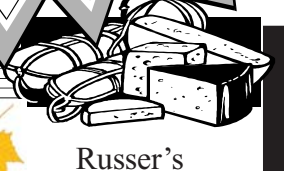

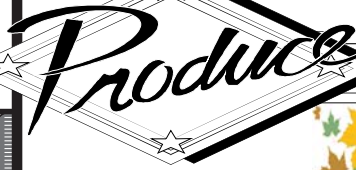
